Duties and Responsibilities:

- Wear a clean uniform daily and be personally neat and clean.
- Give fast and friendly service and follow recommended checklist procedures.
- Discuss any scheduling with Supervisor.
- Refer all parts and service orders to Shop Manager.
- Change oil, grease, filters, thermostats, brakes, exhaust etc. on vehicles.
- Repair, change, mount, and inspect tires for customers.
- Become familiar with auto, truck, implement and tractor tire line.
- Keep vehicle comebacks to a minimum.
- Keep tools, floors, benches, and general work area clean and free of clutter at all times in order to improve the image of the services we perform.
- Assist in doing your part in the common housekeeping duties as listed on the Shop Managers work list.
- Use work orders for any service work performed.

- Have all work orders filled out upon completion of each job and submit to Shop Manager immediately for billing.
- Keep customers vehicles clean, free of grease and dirt smudges by using throw covers, floor mats and by cleaning hands before entering customer's vehicles.
- Keep up to date and knowledgeable on products available.
- Attend product, merchandising and cooperative meetings regularly.
- Sell replacement items such as wiper blades, fan belts, batteries, filters, tires and etc.
- Perform other duties within the coop as assigned by the Service Manager.
